AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE ABANDONMENT OF
ALREADY DISCONTINUED PORTIONS OF OLD ROUTES 640 AND
58 ALT. IN THE ST. PAUL AREA

WHEREAS, the Virginia Department of Transportation discontinued portions of old Routes 640 and 58 Alt. in the St. Paul area in conjunction with the construction of the current Route 58 Alt.; and
