AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PARKING WITH THE
BOUNDARIES OF THE SOUTHWEST VIRGINIA COMMUNITY
COLLEGE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Russell County, Virginia, that:

SECTION I. It shall be unlawful for any person to park a vehicle or permit it to stand, whether attended or unattended, in any area not designated as a parking area by conspicuously posted signs upon the campus or grounds of the Southwest Virginia Community College.

SECTION II. No vehicle shall be stopped or parked in an manner so as to impede or render dangerous the use of streets, highways, or access roads to, from and through parking areas on said campus. In the event of accident or mechanical failure, the police or college authorities shall be notified at once and the vehicle shall be removed without unreasonable delay, and if such vehicle shall be removed without unreasonable delay, and if such vehicle is not promptly removed, such removal may be ordered by a police officer at the expense of the owner.

SECTION III. No person shall park a vehicle or permit a vehicle to stand, whether attended or unattended, in manner to block access to or egress from service roads, entrances, delivery and service areas, streets or driveways on said campus.

SECTION IV. It shall be unlawful to park a vehicle, or to permit a vehicle to stand, whether attended or unattended, in parking areas restricted in use and clearly designated by signs, unless, and until, such vehicle exhibits proper parking sticker issued by the college.

SECTION V. It shall be unlawful to park a vehicle upon grounds or campus of the Southwest Virginia Community College for a period longer than twelve consecutive hours without prior written consent of the President or Dean.

SECTION VI. It shall be unlawful for any person to deface, tamper with, damage, or impair the usefulness of any traffic or parking signs erected by the college.

VIOLATION of this ordinance by any person is declared a misdemeanor, and it shall be the duty of all police officers to enforce its provisions, and violation thereof shall be punished by a fine not exceeding twenty dollars (\$20.00). The County Court of Russell, Virginia shall have jurisdiction to try cases arising hereunder.
