AMENDED MOTOR VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC CODE

ORDINANCE

Public hearing was held pursuant to law after having been advertised in the Lebanon News for two successive weeks.

Motion made by John Bryan, seconded by Richard Settle and unanimously approved by the Russell County Board of Supervisors that following ordinance to amend the MOTOR VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC CODE ORDINANCE effective July 1, 1984 be adopted:

ORDINANCE

An ordinance to adopt State laws regarding motor vehicles and traffic:

Pursuant to the Authority of Section 46.1-188 of the Code of Virginia (1950 as amended), all of the provisions and requirements of the laws of the State contained in Title 46.1 of the Code of Virginia (1950 as amended), except those provisions and requirements the violation of which constitutes a felony, and except those provisions and requirements which by their very nature can have no application to or within the County; and the provisions of Article 2, of Chapter 7, of Title 18.2 of the Code of Virginia (1950 as amended), are hereby adopted and incorporated in this Chapter by reference and made applicable within the County. References to "highways of the State" contained in such provisions and requirements hereby adopted shall be deemed to refer to the streets, highways and other public ways within the County. Such provisions and requirement are hereby adopted, mutatis mutandis, and made a part of the Chapter as fully as though set forth at length herein; and it shall be unlawful for any person, within the County, to violate or fail, neglect or refuse, to comply with any provision of the Title 46.1 of the Code of Virginia (1950 as amended) or Article 2 Chapter 7, of Title 18.2 of the Code of Virginia (1950 as amended), which is adopted by this section, provided, that in no event shall the penalty imposed for the violation of any provision or requirement hereby adopted exceed the penalty imposed for a similar offense under Title 46.1 of the Code of Virginia (1950 as amended), or Article 2, Chapter 7, of Title 18.2 of the Code of Virginia (1950 as amended).
