PUBLIC HEARING HELD ON APPLICATION  
FOR ABANDONMENT - PORTION OF THE C. D. PORTER SUBDIVISION

Pursuant to application for abandonment filed by the affected landowners, and upon proper advertising and subsequent to public hearing, the following of the C. D. Porter Subdivision be, and hereby is vacated:

Upon motion made by John Bryan, second by R. L. Settle, and duly passed by the Russell County Board of Supervisors that following Ordinance be adopted:

O R D I N A N C E

The following part or portion of the C. D. Porter lands subdivision, being a platted sub division street which has never been opened or developed, be, and is by this ordinance, vacated, to wit:

Beginning at a point in the common corner of lots 53, 54, and 55 of the C. D. Porter lands subdivided; thence with the boundary of lot 45, N 09 55 W 40 feet to the corner of lot 44; thence, N 80 05 E passing the lots numbered 44, 43, 42, 41, and 40, being a distance of 125 feet, thence crossing the 40-foot platted street S. 09 55 E to a point in the boundary of lot 58; thence following the boundary of lot 58 in a northerly direction along an arc with radius of 14; thence continuing with the boundary of lot 58, S 80 05 W 10 feet; thence with the lot lines of lots 57, 56, 55, and 54, S 80 05 W 100 feet to the point of beginning and being the unused and undeveloped street shown on the map or plat attached to the landowner's application.

Recordation of this ordinance shall operate to destroy the force and effect of the recording of the part of the plat so vacated, and to vest fee simple title to the centerline of the street so vacated in the owners of abutting lots free and clear of any rights of the public or other owners of lots shown on the plat, but subject to the rights of the owners of any public utility installations which have been previously erected therein.
