6 **TO ESTABLISH BOUNDARY LINES OF ELECTION PRECINCTS; AND**
7 **TO ESTABLISH A CENTRAL ABSENTEE VOTER PRECINCT**
8 **RUSSELL COUNTY, VIRGINIA**

10 **CHAPTER 1.**

11 **ARTICLE 1.**

12 *Applicability; Magisterial District Lines; Representation by Election Districts*

13 Section 24.2-100. Applicability of Title – The provisions of this ordinance shall
14 apply to all elections held in this County except as otherwise provided by general law.

15 Section 24.2-101. Magisterial District Lines – The Magisterial District Lines of
16 Russell County as established by Order of the Circuit Court of Russell County, Virginia
17 as set forth in Deed Book 204 Page 306 in E.W. Callenbach, et als. (petitioners) v
18 County of Russell, Virginia (defendant) shall remain the same.

19 Section 24.2-102. Representation of Governing Body. – Representation on the
20 governing body of Russell County shall be by election districts, from each of which one
21 (1) member of the Russell County Board of Supervisors shall be elected and one (1) at-
22 large member elected from the entire county. The combined membership of the Russell
23 County Board of Supervisors shall be seven (7).

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1 Virginia Secondary Route 609 (W. Bearwallow Rd.); thence in a northerly direction with
2 Virginia Secondary Route 609 to its intersection with Virginia Secondary Route 685
3 (Vanderpool Dr.); thence in a northeasterly direction with the meanders of Virginia
4 Secondary Route 685 to its intersection with Virginia Secondary Route 611 (Ervintown
5 Rd.); thence in a northeasterly direction with the meanders of Virginia Secondary Route
6 611 to its intersection with American Electric Company's Clinch River – Hill 138 KV
7 power line; thence running with said power line in a northeasterly direction to its
8 intersection with U.S. Highway 58; thence in a northerly direction with U.S. Highway 58
9 to its intersection with Virginia Secondary Route 683 (Memorial Dr.); thence in a
10 easterly direction with the meanders of Virginia Secondary Route 683 to its intersection
11 with Virginia Secondary Route 669 (Seven Springs Rd); thence in a southeasterly
12 direction with Virginia Secondary Route 669 to its intersection with American Electric
13 Company's Clinch River – Hill 138 KV power line; thence in a northeasterly direction
14 with said power line to its intersection with Virginia Secondary Route 667 (Century Farm
15 Rd); thence in a southeasterly direction with the meanders of Virginia Secondary Route
16 667 to its intersection with the Castlewood – Lebanon Magisterial District Line as
17 established by the above referenced Order of the Circuit Court of Russell County;
18 thence in an easterly direction with the meanders of the Castlewood – Lebanon
19 Magisterial District Line to its intersection with American Electric Company's Clinch
20 River – Hill 138 KV power line; thence in a southeasterly direction with said power line
21 to the top of Clinch Mountain; thence in a southwesterly direction with the Russell –
22 Washington County Line to the BEGINNING.

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(1 (Jessees Mill Rd.); thence in a southerly direction with Virginia Secondary Route 645 to
2 its intersection with Virginia Secondary Route 640 (Long Hollow Rd.); thence in a
3 southeasterly direction with Virginia Secondary Route 640 to the intersection with the
4 Castlewood – Lebanon Magisterial District Line as established by the above referenced
5 Order of the Circuit Court of Russell County, thence in a southwesterly direction with the
6 meanders of the Castlewood – Lebanon Magisterial District Line to the intersection of
7 Virginia Secondary Route 667 (Century Farm Rd.); thence in a northerly direction with
8 the meanders of Virginia Secondary Route 667 to its intersection with American Electric
9 Company's Clinch River - Hill 138 KV power line; thence running with said power line in
10 a westerly direction to the intersection of Virginia Secondary Route 669 (Seven Springs
11 Rd.); thence in a northwesterly direction to the intersection of Virginia Secondary Route
12 683 (Memorial Drive); thence in a northerly direction with the meanders of Virginia
(13 Secondary Route 683 to its intersection with U.S. Highway 58; thence in a southerly
14 direction to its intersection with American Electric Company's Clinch River - Hill 138 KV
15 power line; thence in a westerly direction with said power line to its intersection with
16 Virginia Secondary Route 611 (Ervintown Rd); thence in a southwesterly direction with
17 the meanders of Virginia Secondary Route 611 to its intersection with Virginia
18 Secondary Route 685 (Vanderpool Dr.); thence in a westerly direction to intersection
19 with Virginia Secondary Route 609 (W Bearwallow Rd); thence in a southerly direction
20 to its intersection with Virginia Secondary Route 610 (Sunny Point Rd.); thence in a
21 westerly direction to its intersection with the Russell – Scott County Line to the point of
22 BEGINNING.

1 **ARTICLE 4.**

2 *Boundary Description of Election District No. 3-2010.*

3 Section 24.2-204 – The Boundary of Election District No. 3-2010 is as follows:

4 BEGINNING at a point which is a common corner of Russell – Dickenson –
5 Buchanan Counties; thence running in a southwesterly direction with the Russell –
6 Dickenson County Line to a point north of the intersection of Virginia Secondary Route
7 616 (Cheney Creek Rd.) and Virginia Secondary Route 657 (Hazel Mountain Rd.) in the
8 Russell – Dickenson County Line; thence in a southeasterly direction to intersection of
9 Virginia Secondary Route 616 (Cheney Creek Rd.); thence in a southeasterly direction
10 with the meanders of Virginia Secondary Route 616 to its intersection with Virginia
11 Secondary Route 615 (Gravel Lick Rd.); thence in a westerly direction with Virginia
12 Secondary Route 615 to its intersection with Virginia Secondary Route 700 (Eagles
13 Nest Rd.); thence in a southerly direction with Virginia Secondary Route 700 to the
14 intersection with Virginia Secondary Route 628 (Heralds Valley Rd.); thence in a
15 westerly direction with Virginia Secondary Route 628 to its intersection with Virginia
16 Secondary Route 614 (Carterton Rd.); thence in a southerly direction with Virginia
17 Secondary Route 614 to its intersection with Virginia Secondary Route 640 (Middle
18 Valley Rd.); thence in a northeasterly direction with Virginia Secondary Route 640 to its
19 intersection with Virginia Secondary Route 645 (Jessees Mill Rd.); thence in a southerly
20 direction with Virginia Secondary Route 645 to its intersection with Virginia Secondary
21 Route 640 (Long Hollow Rd.); thence in a southeasterly direction with Virginia
22 Secondary Route 640 to the intersection with the Castlewood – Lebanon Magisterial
23 District Line; thence in a westerly direction to Virginia Secondary Route 640 to its

1 intersection with abandoned Virginia Secondary Route 672; thence in a northwesterly
2 direction in a straight line to a point southwest of the intersection of Virginia Secondary
3 Route 882 (Lost Valley Rd), Virginia Secondary Route 640, and north of Gray Cemetery
4 (as shown on the U.S. Geological Survey map " Lebanon Quadrangle"); thence in an
5 easterly direction in a straight line to the intersection with Virginia Highway 82
6 (Cleveland Rd.); thence in a southerly direction with the meanders of Virginia Highway
7 82 (Cleveland Rd.); to its intersection with Virginia Secondary Route 640 (River
8 Mountain Rd); thence in a northwesterly direction with the meanders of Virginia
9 Secondary Route 640 (River Mountain Rd.) to its intersection with American Electric
10 Company's Carbo – Elk Garden – Saltville No. 2 138 KV power line; thence in a
11 southeasterly direction with said power line to its intersection with Big Cedar Creek;
12 thence in a northerly direction approximately 900 feet following the meanders of Big
13 Cedar Creek to a point; thence in an easterly direction to the crest of the Doubles and
14 River Mountain (as shown on the U.S. Geological Survey map " Elk Garden
15 Quadrangle"); thence in an easterly direction, with the meanders of the crest of the
16 Doubles and River Mountain to a point known as Big Rock (as shown on U.S.
17 Geological Survey Map "Elk Garden Quadrangle"); thence in an easterly direction to its
18 intersection with Virginia Highway 80 (Redbud Hwy.); thence in a southerly direction
19 with Virginia Highway 80 to its intersection with American Electric Company's Baker –
20 Broadford 765 KV power line; thence in a southeasterly direction with said power line to
21 its intersection with Mill Branch (as shown on the U.S. Geological Survey Map " Elk
22 Garden Quadrangle"); thence in a northeasterly direction in a straight line to the
23 intersection with Virginia Secondary Route 640 (Clifton Farm Rd); thence in a

1 northwesterly direction with Virginia Secondary Route 640 to its intersection with
2 Virginia Secondary Route 630 (Kents Ridge Rd); thence in a northerly direction with
3 Virginia Secondary Route 630 (Kents Ridge Rd) to its intersection with the Clinch River;
4 thence in a westerly direction with the meanders of the Clinch River to its intersection
5 with Lewis Creek; thence in a northerly direction with Lewis Creek to it intersect the
6 Town of Honaker Corporation limits; thence in a westerly direction with the Town of
7 Honaker Corporation limits to its intersection with Virginia Secondary Route 646 (Tunnel
8 Rd.); thence in a northeasterly direction with the Town of Honaker Corporation Limits to
9 its intersection with Virginia Highway 80 (Redbud Hwy.); thence in a westerly direction
10 with the meanders of Town of Honaker Corporation Limits to its intersection with
11 Virginia Highway 67 (Swords Creek Rd); thence in a northeasterly direction with Virginia
12 Highway 67 to its intersection with Virginia Secondary Route 637 (Wysor Valley Rd);
13 thence in a northwest direction with Virginia Secondary Route 637 to its intersection
14 with Virginia Secondary Route 780; thence in a northwesterly direction, a straight line, to
15 a point on the crest of Stone Cove Ridge, elevation 2,796 ft. (as shown on U.S.
16 Geological Survey Map "Honaker Quadrangle"), a common point in the New Garden,
17 Drill and Swords Creek Precinct Lines; thence in a southwesterly direction a straight
18 line, which touches the northern terminus of Virginia Secondary Route 715 (Stone
19 Mountain Rd) to a point where it intersects with Virginia Secondary Route 624 (Drill Rd)
20 and Laurel Branch; thence in a northwesterly direction with the meanders of Laurel
21 Branch to the headwaters of Laurel Branch near Jackson Cemetery (as shown on U.S.
22 Geological Survey Map "Big A Mountain Quadrangle"); thence in a northerly direction to

1 its intersection with the Russell – Buchanan County Line, a common corner of the New
2 Garden - Drill Precincts; thence in a southwesterly direction to the point of BEGINNING.

4 **ARTICLE 5.**

5 *Boundary Description of Election District No 4 – 2010.*

6 Section 24.2-205 – The Boundary of Election District No. 4-2010 is as follows:

7 BEGINNING at a point in the Buchanan – Russell County Line just north of
8 Laurel Branch; thence leaving the Buchanan – Russell County Line and running in a
9 southeasterly direction to the headwaters of Laurel Branch; thence in a southeasterly
10 direction with the meanders of Laurels Branch to a point where it intersects with Virginia
11 Secondary Route 624 (Drill Rd.); thence leaving Laurel Branch and running in a straight
12 line in a northeasterly direction (which line touches the northern terminus of Virginia
13 Secondary Route 715) to the headwaters of Stone Branch; thence in a southeasterly
14 direction to the intersection of Virginia Secondary Route 780 (Call Valley Rd.) and
15 Virginia Secondary Route 637; thence with Virginia Secondary Route 637 in a
16 southeasterly direction to the intersection of Virginia Highway 67 (Swords Creek Rd.);
17 thence in a southwesterly direction with the meanders of Virginia Highway 67 to its
18 intersection with the Town of Honaker Corporation Limits; thence in a northwestern
19 direction with the meanders of the Town of Honaker Corporation Limits to its
20 intersection with Virginia Highway 80 (Redbud Hwy.); thence in a southwesterly
21 direction with the meanders of the Town of Honaker Corporation Limits to its
22 intersection with Virginia Secondary Route 646 (Tunnel Rd.); thence in a southeasterly
23 direction with the meanders of the Town of Honaker Corporation Limits to its

1 intersection with Lewis Creek; thence in a southerly direction with the meanders of
2 Lewis Creek to its intersection with the Clinch River; thence in an easterly direction with
3 the meanders of the Clinch River to its intersection with Little River; thence in a easterly
4 direction with the meanders of Little River to it intersection with the Russell – Tazewell
5 County Line; thence in a northwesterly direction with the Russell – Tazewell County Line
6 to its intersection with the corner of Russell – Tazewell – Buchanan County Line; thence
7 in a southwestern direction with the Russell – Buchanan line to the point of
8 BEGINNING.

10 **ARTICLE 6.**

11 *Boundary Description of Election District No. 5-2010.*

12 Section 24.2-206 – The Boundary of Election District No. 5-2010 is as follows:

13 BEGINNING at a point where Virginia Secondary Route 657 (Green Valley Rd.)
14 intersects with Virginia Secondary Route 1063 (Rolling Meadows Rd.); thence in a
15 southerly direction with Virginia Secondary Route 1063 and beyond its termination in a
16 straight line to the Russell – Washington County Line at the top of Clinch Mountain;
17 thence with the meanders of the Russell – Washington County Line in a southwesterly
18 direction to its intersection with American Electric Company's Clinch River – Saltville
19 No. 2 line 138KV power line; thence in a northwesterly direction with said power line to
20 its intersection with the Castlewood – Lebanon Magisterial District line, as established
21 by the above referenced Order of the Circuit Court of Russell County; thence in a
22 northeasterly direction with the meanders of the Castlewood – Lebanon Magisterial
23 District Line to its intersection with Virginia Secondary Route 640 (Long Hollow Rd.);

1 thence in a westerly direction to Virginia Secondary Route 640 to its intersection with
2 abandoned Virginia Secondary Route 672; thence in a northwesternly direction in a
3 straight line to a point southwest of the intersection of Virginia Secondary Route 882
4 (Lost Valley Rd), Virginia Secondary Route 640, and north of Gray Cemetery (as shown
5 on the U.S. Geological Survey map " Lebanon Quadrangle"); thence in an easterly
6 direction in a straight line to its intersection with Virginia Highway 82 (Cleveland Rd.);
7 thence in a southerly direction with the meanders of Virginia Highway 82 (Cleveland
8 Rd.) to its intersection with Virginia Secondary Route 640 (River Mountain Rd.); thence
9 in a northwesterly direction with the meanders of Virginia Secondary Route 640 (River
10 Mountain Rd.) to its intersection with American Electric Company's Clinch River –
11 Saltville 138 KV power line; thence in a southeasterly direction with said power line to its
12 intersection with Big Cedar Creek; thence in a southerly direction with the meanders of
13 Big Cedar Creek to its intersection with E. Main St.; thence westerly direction to its
14 intersection with Virginia Secondary Route 658 (Big Cedar Creek Rd); thence in a
15 southerly direction with Virginia Secondary Route 658 to its intersection with Elliott Dr;
16 thence in a westerly direction with the meanders of Elliott Dr. to its intersection with
17 Regional Park Rd.; thence in a northerly direction to its intersection with U.S. Highway
18 19; thence in a westerly direction with U.S. Highway 19 to a point at the start of the
19 Lebanon Second Southbound Exit; thence in a straight line to the intersection of Ketron
20 Ave. and Career Tech Dr.; thence following the meanders of Career Tech Dr. to the
21 intersection of Pittston Rd.; thence in a southerly direction to its intersection with
22 Regional Park Rd.; thence in southeasterly direction, in a straight line, to the Town of
23 Lebanon Corporation Limits; thence in a westerly direction with the Town of Lebanon

1 Corporation Limits to its intersection with Virginia Secondary Route 654 (Pittston Rd.);
2 thence in a southerly direction, leaving the Town of Lebanon Corporation Limits, to its
3 intersection with Virginia Secondary Route 664, (Stone Bruise Rd.); thence in a westerly
4 direction with the meanders of Virginia Secondary Route 659 to its intersection with
5 Virginia Secondary Route 660 (Coal Tipple Hollow); thence in a southerly direction with
6 Virginia Secondary Route 660 to its intersection with Virginia Secondary Route 657
7 (Green Valley Rd.); thence in a northeasterly direction with Virginia Secondary Route
8 657 to its intersection with Virginia Secondary Route 1063 the point of BEGINNING.

10 **ARTICLE 7.**

11 *Boundary Description of Election District No. 6-2010.*

12 Section 24.2-207 – The Boundary of Election District No. 6-2010 is as follows:

13 BEGINNING at a point where the Little River intersects with the Russell –
14 Tazewell County Line; thence in a southwesterly direction with the meanders of the
15 Little River, the Lebanon – New Garden Magisterial District Line, as referenced in the
16 above mentioned Order of the Circuit Court of Russell County, to its intersection with
17 Virginia Secondary Route 636 (Kents Ridge Rd.); thence with the meanders of Virginia
18 Secondary Route 636 in a southerly direction to its intersection with Virginia Secondary
19 Route 640 (Clifton Farm Rd.); thence in a southwesterly direction in a straight line to a
20 point where American Power Company's Baker – Broadford 765 KV power line
21 intersects with Mill Branch (as shown on the U.S. Geological Survey Map "Elk Garden
22 Quadrangle"); thence in a northwesterly direction to its intersection with Virginia
23 Highway 80 (Redbud Hwy.); thence in a southerly direction with the meanders of

1 Virginia Highway 80 to the crest of The Doubles and River Mountain (as shown on the
2 U.S. Geological Survey Map "Elk Garden Quadrangle"); thence in a westerly direction,
3 with the meanders of the top of The Doubles and River Mountain to a point known as
4 Big Rock (as shown on U.S. Geological Survey Map "Elk Garden Quadrangle"); thence
5 in a westerly direction, with the meanders of the top of The Doubles and River Mountain
6 to a point in Big Cedar Creek, a common corner of East Lebanon – West Lebanon –
7 Daughterty precincts; thence in a southerly direction with the meanders of Big Cedar
8 Creek to its intersection with E. Main St; thence in a westerly direction to its intersection
9 with Virginia Secondary Route 658 (Big Cedar Creek Rd); thence in a southerly
10 direction with Virginia Secondary Route 658 (Big Cedar Creek Rd) to its intersection
11 with Elliott Dr.; thence in a westerly direction with the meanders of Elliott Dr. to its
12 intersection with Regional Park Rd.; thence in a northerly direction to its intersection
13 with U.S. Highway 19; thence in a westerly direction with U.S. Highway 19 to a point at
14 the start of the Lebanon Second Exit - Southbound; thence in a straight line to the
15 intersection of Ketron Ave. and Career Tech Dr.; thence following the meanders of
16 Career Tech Dr. to the intersection of Pittston Rd.; thence in an southerly direction to its
17 intersection with Regional Park Rd.; thence in a southeasterly direction in a straight line,
18 to the Town of Lebanon Corporation Limits; thence in a westerly direction with the Town
19 of Lebanon Corporation Limits to its intersection with Virginia Secondary Route 654
20 (Pittston Rd.); thence in a southerly direction, leaving the Town of Lebanon Corporation
21 Limits, to its intersection with Virginia Secondary Route 664, (Stone Bruise Rd.); thence
22 in a westerly direction with the meanders of Virginia Secondary Route 659 to its
23 intersection with Virginia Secondary Route 660 (Coal Tipple Hollow); thence in a

1 southerly direction with Virginia Secondary Route 660 to its intersection with Virginia
2 Secondary Route 657 (Green Valley Road); thence in a northeasterly direction with
3 Virginia Secondary Route 657 to its intersection with Virginia Secondary Route 1063
4 (Rolling Meadows Rd.); thence in a southerly direction with Virginia Secondary Route
5 1063 and beyond its termination in a straight line to the Russell – Washington County
6 Line on top of Clinch Mountain; thence with the Russell – Washington County Line in a
7 northeasterly direction to a corner of Russell - Washington – Smyth Counties; thence in
8 a northeasterly direction with the Russell – Smyth County Line to a corner of Russell –
9 Smyth – Tazewell Counties; thence in a northwesterly direction with the Russell –
10 Tazewell County Line to the point of BEGINNING.

13 **ARTICLE 1.**

14 *Naming of Voter Precincts; Designation of Precinct Polling Places; and* 15 *Geographical Boundary Descriptions of Precincts*

16 Section 24.2-300. The named precinct for each election district and the
17 designated polling place for each precinct shall be as follows:

18 A. Election District No. 1 – 2010:

- 19 1. Moccasin Precinct, No. 0101-2010 whose polling place shall be 10244 Moccasin
20 Valley Rd. the former Oak Grove Elementary School;
- 21 2. Copper Creek, No. 0102-2010 whose polling place shall be 23894 U.S. Highway
22 58 at the Copper Creek Elementary School;

1 3. South Castlewood, No. 0103-2010 whose polling place shall be 304 Blue Devil
2 Circle at the Castlewood High School. The actual polling place shall not be in the
3 same room or adjacent to the room used by voting by the registered voters of the
4 North Castlewood, No. 0201-2010 precinct.

5 B. Election District No. 2-2010.

6 1. North Castlewood, No. 0201-2010 whose polling place shall be at 304 Blue Devil
7 Circle the Castlewood High School. The actual polling place shall not be in the
8 same room or adjacent to the room used for voting by the registered voters of
9 South Castlewood, No. 0103-2010 precinct;

10 2. Dante, No. 0202-2010 whose polling place shall be at the 142 Lower Bearwallow
11 Rd. at the Dante Community Center.

12 C. Election District No. 3-2010.

13 1. Cleveland, No. 0304-2010 whose polling place shall be at 35 Riverview Terrace
14 Dr. at the Cleveland Town Hall;

15 2. Cooks Mill, No. 0301-2010 whose polling place shall be at 1374 Finney Rd. the
16 Finney Community Center;

17 3. Daugherty, No. 0302-2010 whose polling place shall be at 4064 River Mountain
18 Rd. at the Oak Grove Church;

19 4. New Garden, No. 0303-2010 whose polling place shall be at 50 Honaker
20 Elementary Rd. at the Honaker Elementary School.

21 D. Election District 4-2010.

22 1. Drill, No. 0401-2010 whose polling place shall be at 6746 Drill Rd. the Drill
23 Community Center;

1 2. Swords Creek, No. 0402-2010 whose polling place shall be at 3867 Swords
2 Creek Rd. at the Swords Creek Elementary School;

3 3. Honaker, No. 0403-2010 whose polling place shall be 1795 Thompson Creek Rd.
4 at the Honaker High School;

5 E. Election District 5-2010.

6 1. West Lebanon, No. 0501-2010 whose polling place shall be at 56 George Ben
7 Whited Dr. at the Lebanon Middle School.

8 F. Election District 6-2010

9 1. East Lebanon, No. 0601-2010 whose polling place shall be at 308 Career Tech

14 **ARTICLE 2.**

15 *Boundary Description Voter Precincts in Election District 1-2010.*

16 Section 24.2-301. – The geographical boundary of the Moccasin Precinct, No.
17 0101-2010 is as follows:

18 BEGINNING at a point which is the southwestern corner of Russell County, a
19 common corner to Russell, Scott and Washington Counties; thence in a northwesterly
20 direction with the boundary of Russell and Scott County to the crest of Moccasin Ridge;
21 thence following the meanders of the crest of Moccasin Ridge to its intersection with
22 Virginia Secondary Route 614 (Cross Roads) and Sinking Creek; thence following the
23 meanders of Sinking Creek to its intersection with American Electric Company's Clinch

1 River – Saltville No. 2 line 138KV; thence in a straight line, a southeasterly direction to
2 the Russell – Washington County Line on top of Clinch Mountain; thence in a
3 southwesterly direction with the meanders of the Russell – Washington County Line to
4 the point of BEGINNING.

5
6 Section 24.2-302. – The geographical boundary of the Copper Creek Precinct,
7 No. 0102-2010 is as follows:

8 BEGINNING at a point in the crest of Moccasin Ridge on the Russell – Scott
9 County Line, the northwest corner of the Moccasin Creek Precinct; thence following the
10 meanders of the crest of Moccasin Ridge to its intersection with Virginia Secondary
11 Route 614 (Cross Roads) and Sinking Creek; thence following the meanders of Sinking
12 Creek to its intersection with American Electric Company's Clinch River – Saltville No. 2
13 line, 138KV; thence running with said power line in a northwesterly direction to its

23 Washington County Line; thence with said power line in a northwesterly direction to the

1 intersection with Virginia primary Highway 80; thence in a northerly direction with
2 Virginia Primary Highway 80 to its intersection with U.S. Highway 19; thence in a
3 straight northwesterly direction to Fuller Cemetery (as shown on U.S. Geological Survey
4 Map "Elk Garden Quadrangle"); thence in a northwesterly direction to a point known as
5 Big Rock (as shown on U.S. Geological Survey Map "Elk Garden Quadrangle") on top
6 of The Doubles and River Mountain Ridge; thence in a westerly direction, with the
7 meanders of the top of The Doubles and River Mountain to a point in Big Cedar Creek,
8 thence in a southerly direction with the meanders of Big Cedar Creek to its intersection
9 with E Main St; thence westerly direction to it intersection with and Virginia Secondary
10 Route 658 (Big Cedar Creek Rd); thence in a southerly direction with Virginia
11 Secondary Route 658 (Big Cedar Creek Rd) to it intersection with Elliott Dr; thence in a
12 westerly direction with the meander of Elliott Dr to its intersection with Regional Park
13 Rd; thence in a northerly direction to it intersection with US Highway 19; thence in a
14 westerly direction with US Highway 19 to the start of the Lebanon Second Southbound
15 Exit; thence in a straight line to the intersection of Ketron Ave and Career Tech Dr;
16 thence following the meanders of Career tech Dr to the intersection of Pittston Rd;
17 thence in an southerly direction to its intersection with Regional Park Rd; thence in
18 southwesterly direction in a straight line, to the Town of Lebanon Corporation Limits;
19 thence in a westerly direction with the Town of Lebanon Corporation Limits to it
20 intersects with Virginia Secondary Route 654 (Pittston Rd); thence in a southerly
21 direction, leaving the Town of Lebanon, to its intersection with Virginia Secondary Route
22 664, (Stone Bruise); thence in a westerly direction with the meanders of Virginia
23 Secondary Route 659 (Stone Bruise to its intersection with Virginia Secondary Route

1 660 (Coal Tipple Hollow); thence in a southerly direction with Virginia Secondary Route
2 660 (Coal Tipple Hollow) to its intersection with Virginia Secondary Route 657 (Green
3 Valley Road); thence in a northeasterly direction with Virginia Secondary Route 657
4 (Green Valley Road) to its intersection with Virginia Secondary Route 1063; thence in a
5 southerly direction with Virginia Secondary Route 1063 and beyond its termination in a
6 straight line to the Russell – Washington County Line on top of Clinch Mountain; thence
7 with the Russell – Washington County Line in a northeasterly direction to the point of
8 BEGINNING.

10 Section 24.2-314 – The geographical boundary of the Elk Garden Precinct, No.
11 602-2010 is as follows:

12 BEGINNING at a point where the Little River intersects with the Russell –
13 Tazewell County Line; thence in a Southwesterly direction with the meanders of the
14 Little River, the Lebanon – New Garden Magisterial District Line, as referred to in the
15 above mentioned Order of the Circuit Court of Russell County to its intersection with
16 Virginia Secondary Route 636; thence with the meanders of Virginia Secondary Route
17 636 in a southerly direction to its intersection with Virginia Secondary Route 640; thence
18 in a southwestern direction in a straight line to its intersection with American Power
19 Company's 138 KV power line; thence in an northwesterly direction to its intersection
20 with Virginia Highway 80 (Redbud Hwy); thence in an southerly direction with the
21 meanders of Virginia Highway 80 to the crest of The Doubles and River Mountain (as
22 shown on the U.S. Geological Survey Map "Elk Garden Quadrangle"); thence in a
23 westerly direction, with the meanders of the top of The Doubles and river Mountain to a

1 point known as Big Rock (as shown on U.S. Geological Survey Map "Elk Garden
2 Quadrangle"); thence in a straight southeasterly direction to Fuller Cemetery (as shown
3 on U.S. Geological Survey Map "Elk Garden Quadrangle"); thence in a straight
4 southeasterly direction to the intersection of U.S. Highway 19 and Virginia Primary
5 Highway 80; thence in a southerly direction with Virginia Primary Highway 80 to its
6 intersection with American Electric Company's Carbo – Elk Garden – Saltville No. 2,
7 138KV power line; thence running with said power line in a southeasterly direction to the
8 top of Clinch Mountain at a point in the Russell – Washington County Line; thence in a
9 northeasterly direction with the Russell – Washington County Line to a corner of Russell
10 - Washington – Smyth Counties; thence in a northeasterly direction with the Russell –
11 Smyth County Line to a corner of Russell – Smyth – Tazewell Counties; thence in a
12 northwesterly direction with the Russell – Tazewell County Line to the point of
13 BEGINNING.

1 §24.2-708 of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended shall be applicable, and the
2 officers shall advise the voter that he may vote on presentation of a statement signed by
3 him that he has not received an absentee ballot and subject to felony penalties for
4 making false statements pursuant to §24.2-1016 of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as
5 amended.

6 D. Absentee ballots may be processed as required by §24.2-711 of the Code
7 of Virginia, 1950, as amended by the officers of election at the Central Absentee Voter
8 precinct prior to the closing of the polls but the ballot box shall not be opened and the
9 counting of ballots shall not begin prior to that time. In the case of punch card or mark
10 sense ballots to be inserted in electronic counting equipment, the ballot box may be
11 opened and the absentee ballots may be inserted in the counting equipment prior to the
12 closing of the polls in accordance with procedures prescribed by the State Electoral
13 Board, including procedures to preserve ballot secrecy, but no ballot count totals shall
14 be initiated prior to that time.

15 As soon as the polls are closed in the county, the officers of election at the
16 Central Absentee Voter Precinct shall proceed to ascertain and record the vote given by
17 absentee ballot and report the results in the manner provided for counting and reporting
18 ballots generally in Article 4 (§24.2-643 et seq.) of Chapter 6 of Title 24.2 Elections,
19 Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended.

20 E. The electoral board may provide that the officers of election for the Central
21 Absentee Voter precinct may be assigned to work all or a portion of the time that the
22 precinct is open on Election Day subject to the following conditions:

1. The chief officer and the assistant chief officer, appointed pursuant to §24.2-115 to represent the two political parties, are on duty at all times; and
2. No officer, political party representative, or other candidate representative shall leave the precinct after any ballots have been counted until the polls are closed and the count for the precinct is completed and reported.
